

## Weekly History Revision Plan

You should be spending at least 1 hour a week on history revision in the run up to exams and you should start your revision programme early. The tasks listed below will take more than 1 hour a week so choose the ones that help you the most. This is to be used alongside revision done in class and intervention sessions.

Regular revision is the key to success at GCSE – remember ‘**little, but often**’ – 15 mins focussed **active** revision followed by a short break preferably in another room. Then return to revision and so on...

**Just reading is not usually effective** revision – make revision active:

- Make and use revision cards – look, cover, remember (even better – get someone to test you on the contents).
- Make mind maps and display them around your room
- Practice questions and mark them – ask yourself – ‘Why did I drop marks? What do I still need to learn?’
